

WINDOWS 7 IMPROVEMENT FROM DISKEEPER

"We manufacture a neurological monitoring system. This system has a PC (laptop/desktop with Windows 7) where our app is running to provide the technologist vital data during neuro-surgery. The system uses a lot of disk space during the surgery and this causes fragmentation of the hard drive. In the past we have had problems with customer claims about slow running systems and delays. After we installed Diskeeper on the systems almost all of these claims disappeared.

After 20-30 minutes of defragmentation the result is OK. After couple of days/weeks, the hard drives become very fragmented which decreases the speed of the system.
